Medicine	Status	Indication	Other Information		
Clonidine	Deferred	Spasticity in children and young people	Deferred to the Trust Drugs and Therapeutics Committee to consider a RED classification		
Glycopyrronium bromide (oral)	Amber 2	Hypersalivation in Parkinson's Disease	 NOTE there are two strengths of glycopyrronium on the formulary; 1mg/5ml and 2mg/5ml. Care should be taken to select the correct product when prescribing and dispensing 		
Inhixa® (enoxaparin biosimilar)	Amber 2	Antiplatelet	 Prescribe by brand Slightly different device to Clexane Prescribers should ensure patients are counselled on the device issued 		
Thealoz Duo®	GREY	Ophthalmology	Lack of evidence of cost effectiveness		
Semaglutide (Ozempic®)	Amber 2	Diabetes	Once weekly in addition to other medicinal products for the treatment of diabetes. A pre-filled pen with four doses and needles so no additional prescribing of needles is required

Freestyle Libre Update

From 1st April 2019 there will be centralised funding available for a proportion of the Freestyle Libre Flash Glucose Monitoring sensors which are prescribed in primary care.

NHS England have issued guidance on eligibility criteria and we are working through this with our local specialists to update our own criteria

Please note;

- Initiation will remain restricted to consultant endocrinologist only
- 6 month review and continuation criteria will remain in place
- Patients will still be expected to complete a structured education programme and will be expected to maintain appropriate frequency of testing.
- The DVLA now recognise monitoring in this way as appropriate for drivers



Horizon Scanning, Formulary amendments and traffic light changes

Horizon scanning - Grey classification assigned until formal submission is requested

- ⇒ Eslicarbazepine 50mg/ml susp AMBER 2 for patients unable to swallow tablets
- ⇒ Staplex (salmeterol/fluticasone 50/500 DPI) GREY
- ⇒ Symkevi (Tezacaftor/ivacaftor 100mg/150mg tablets) GREY
- ⇒ Oxypro (Oxycodone MR tablets) delayed until further risk assessment complete

Formulary amendments and traffic light changes

- Gamolenic acid and evening primrose oil GREY in line with self care agenda
- ♦ Formoterol 12mcg MDI (Atimos) AMBER 3 in line with guidelines
- Fixapost (latanoprost and timolol preservative free eye drops) AMBER 2 in place of Taptiqom which is now GREY
- Ketotifen PF eye drops GREEN
- Kerraped offloading boot GREEN
- Calfovit D3 sachet GREEN
- Lubiprostone GREY as product now withdrawn
