## Position Statement: Retrospective Prescribing



## **Retrospective Prescribing**

Community pharmacies or Dispensing Appliance Contractors (DAC) must wait until they have received a prescription before supplying the medication or product to the patient. An exception to this is when the **prescriber** has requested an emergency supply of the medication or product. In these instances, the prescriber must agree to send a prescription to the community pharmacy or DAC within 72 hours of making the request.

If the community pharmacy or DAC supplies medications or products without a valid prescription or a request for an emergency supply from a prescriber, this is done at their own risk. Requests for retrospective prescriptions will not be supported.
