New drug submissions— March 2020 APC Decisions

Medicine	Traffic light status	Indication	Other Information
Betesil® 2.250 mg medicated plaster (Betametasone)	AMBER 2	For patients with inflammatory skin disorders which do not respond to treatment with less potent corticosteroids	Plasters may be cut to size
Dacepton (Apomorphine) injection for sc pump	AMBER 1	For patients with refractory motor fluctuations in Parkinson's disease ('off' episodes) inadequately controlled by levodopa with dopa-decarboxylase inhibitor or other dopaminergics	Prescribe by brand
Chloral Betaine 707mg tablets	AMBER 2	For paediatric use for the treatment of insomnia, as a substitute for chloral hydrate liquid	where liquid is unsuitable due to ketogenic diet.

Horizon Scanning, Formulary amendments and traffic light changes

Horizon scanning - GREY classification assigned until formal submission:

- Spravato 28 mg nasal spray, solution®. Esketamine Hydrochloride
- Sunosi 75 mg film-coated tablets®, Solriamfetol Hydrochloride

Formulary amendments and traffic light changes:

- Gestone® amended to GREY as no longer available
- Antibiotics: Clindamycin, Co-trimoxazole, Vancomycin caps and tinidazole updated to AMBER 3 in line with guidelines
- Domperidone for children under 12 years- reclassification from GREEN to AMBER 2 for gut motility
- Melatonin, Colonis brand and Pharma Nord UK preparation—clarified as GREY
- Sucralfate oral suspension (sugar free) 1g/ 5mL—licensed preparation now available, classified as AMBER 2
